JOURNEY TO ACCEPTANCE

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(SLO)

Projekt je odgovor na povečanje ksenofobičnega in rasističnega odnosa v celotni Evropi v zadnjih letih. Tečaj usposabljanja za mladinske delavce, ki sodelujejo v vsakodnevem delu (8 nevladnih organizacij - 2 osebi iz vsake partnerske organizacije) je namenjen povečanju njihovih znanj in kompetenc kot spodbujevalcev pri delu z mladino, zlasti na področju antidiskriminacije. Med 7-dnevnim usposabljanjem se bodo mladinski delavci naučili različnih metod dela z mladino, kot so: igra vlog, simulacijska igra, delo z videom, različne metode skupinskega dela. Govorili bomo o jeziku oziroma načinu govora, ki ga je treba uporabljati med delavnicami, o medkulturni komunikaciji in metodah dela. Zelo pomemben del usposabljanja bo uporaba znanja v praksi, saj bodo udeleženci na usposabljanju pripravili lastne delavnice na temo antidiskriminacije. Po usposabljanju bodo udeleženci pripravili pripraviti delavnice za mlade. Delavnice bodo izvajali nato v Odesi (Ukrajina), kjer bo potekala mladinska izmenjava.

The project is the answer for the increase of xenophobic and racist attitude in the whole Europe last years. We still see the need to speak about acceptance and work on that field.

Training course for youth workers engaged in the daily work of 8 NGO (2 persons from each partner organisation) aims to increase their skills and competences as a facilitators in the work with youth, especially in the field of antidiscrimination. During 7 days training (plus 2 days travel) youth workers will learn different methods of work with youth such as: drama, simulation game, work with video, different methods of group work. It will be also the space to speak about language which should be used during the workshops, about intercultural communication and methods of evaluation. Very important part of the training will be using the knowledge in the practice participants will prepare and provide in international groups short sessions which will be evaluated together with the facilitators. After the training participants will be ready to prepare and provide the workshops for youth. The space to check acquired skills will be the youth exchange, which will be the second activity in the project taking place in Odessa (Ukraine) in November 2017.
