

NAME OF THE CAMPAIGN: HEART - MORE

GOAL:

Tackling systemic racism against black people through theatrical workshops and campaigns in school with NGOs

CAMPAIGN DESCRIPTION

The campaign will take place in Bari, Cagliari, Taranto and Tortona (Turin). All of our organisations are involved in the frame of antidiscriminatory campaigns and we will involve immigrants of African geographical backgrounds in non formal education activities like playroles, pantomimes, sketches and informative campaign in schools.

It will impact black people letting them know that integration is possible when prejudices are overcome and that stereotypical ideas against black people by social media are not embraced by everyone else in the local community. On the contrary, the aim of our initiative is just to implement active citizenship in black people living in our local communities and to make them more integrated in the local communities.
