Cyberincluding goes Europe, kot nakazuje že njen naslov, je zavezana, da bo nadgradila dobro prakso, ki izhaja iz prejšnjega nacionalnega projekta proti kibernetiskemu ustrahovanju (ustanovljenega s programom E +), da bi doseglia čim večje rezultate, si prizadevala na ravni EU, vključevala nova vprašanja, orodja in prakse, ki ustvarajo priložnosti za udeležbo mladih pri odločitvah, ki jih neposredno zadevajo in korak naprej, da zagovarjajo njihove potrebe in ideje. Delovalo bo z metodologijo neformalnega učenja, ki bo vključevala mlade, šole (vsaj 3 šole v državi - skupaj 15 šol, 25 učiteljev in 400 učencev) javne ustanove (vsaj 10 vključenih), strokovnjaki, oblikovalci politike (vsaj 10 vključenih), organizacije civilne družbe, ki spodbujajo opolnomočenje mladih in so udeleženi na področju boja proti nasilju in za bolj povezano Evropo.

Udeleženci: 25 udeležencev starih med 17 – 25 let + 1 mladinski vodja

‘Cyberincluding goes Europe’, as its title already suggests, is committed to upscale a good practice arising from a previous national project against cyberbullying (founded by E+ programme), maximizing the results, endeavouring it to EU level, integrating new issues, tools and practices, creating opportunities for youngsters to take part in the decisions that directly affect them and taking a step forward to advocate their needs and ideas.

‘Cyberincluding goes Europe’ will work in a transnational cross-sectorial way, with a bottom-up approach and with the methodology of non-formal learning, involving young people, schools (at least 3 schools per country – in total 15 schools, 25 teachers and 400 students) public institutions (at least 10 involved), experts, policy makers (at least 10 involved), civil society organizations, fostering youth empowerment and participation in the anti-bullying field as a catalyst for change (policy, behavioural and competences level) and for a more connected Europe against Eu disengagement.

Duration: 2 years of projects with different activities

Places of activities: Italy, Estonia, Slovenia, Spain, UK

Participants: 25 participants aged between 17 - 25 years + 1 youth leader

Planned participating countries: Slovenia, Italy, Great Britain, Spain, Estonia
