With youth exchange Hands up for tolerance we aim to bring youth closer to our differences and to bring together young people from different economic, cultural and ethnic backgrounds, different religions and young people with fewer opportunities, and bring them closer to the diversity and the needed equality among all.

We want to give participants from Cyprus, Italy, Germany, Serbia and Slovenia the opportunity to meet new people and their stories, while also educating our young volunteers how to offer equal dialogue when people from different backgrounds are involved.

The goals of youth exchange are to raise awareness of, and recognise, issues of intolerance and discrimination, to promote youth responsibility, to recognise the signs of discrimination, to encourage youth to be tolerant and active European citizens, to establish dialogue between young people from different ethnic and cultural backgrounds, longterm networking and involvement of participants and organisations and inclusion of new organisations.
