This project has the objective to help young people from North Macedonia, Italy, Slovenia, Romania and Poland to learn how to be active citizens in their community and empower them, as well to encourage them to be multipliers on the knowledge and spread the message and the knowledge in wider scale so we can make our communities inclusive and accepting for every individual living in them. The issues we want to discuss within this project are active youth participation in the community, human rights, advocacy, especially advocacy and influence of young people on the decision making bodies and processes in their community, which will result having better youth policies and politics in the community they live.

Participants will gain :

- Knowledge about the concepts of active citizenship, participatory democracy, basic human rights ;
- Knowledge about the situation in different European countries and communities with a focus on North Macedonia, Italy, Slovenia, Poland and Romania (challenge, approaches and policies);
- Discovering and sharing good practices and examples of Civil Activism;
- Empowerment for Civil Engagement and Advocacy in the home communities;
- Benefits of the non formal education, intercultural learning and communication, social inclusion
